HAPPY SPRING DAY!!!! With September we enter the Season of Creation and use this as a touch point to reflect on our stewardship of all the gifts God has given to us.

Scholars have identified 4 principles of Biblical Stewardship that form the foundation for our reflection:

- The principle of Ownership. The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it (Psalm 24:1) This is the fundamental principle of biblical stewardship. God owns everything and we are merely managers of His possessions
- The principle of <u>Responsibility</u>. Owners have rights, stewards have responsibilities. Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. Luke 16: 10-12.
- The principle of <u>Accountability</u> This is the maxim taught by the Parable of the Talents. God has entrusted authority over the creation to us and we are not allowed to rule over it as we see fit. We are called to exercise our dominion under the watchful eye of the Creator managing his creation in accord with the principles he has established.
- The principle of <u>Reward</u>. Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving. Col 3:23-24.

God challenges us: "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this, says the LORD Almighty, and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it" (Malachi 3:10) May God bless our community as we step into this call.
