Beautiful saints, grace and peace be upon you.

As we settle into a rhythm and deepen our relationship I want to assure each of you of my continued prayers. I am inspired by Paul's prayer in our Ephesians reading this week (Ephesians 1: 15-23) and will make this my daily intercession for us as individuals and as a community.

This week we mark "the waiting" between the Ascension and Pentecost as the early disciples did. And so we wait on God for the Spirit of Truth that will teach us all things and lead us into the will of God for our community. It is therefore a perfect time for our Parish Planning Day on **8 June from 9h30 – 12h30** followed by a bring and braai. I want to share my approach and design for this day, so that we may soak the process in prayer, and encourage as many of us as possible to attend.

Our starting point is always *the One in whom we live, and move and have our being* (Acts17:28). So we begin the process by discerning together the special purpose for which God has called us together in this place. We will uncover this by exploring our personal faith journeys that have led us to choose this community and the deepest desires of God this represents. Once we have clarity on the place to which God seeks to lead us we will embrace this season of transition and develop an action plan.

Theory on transition shows us that this season releases 3 important imperatives that need to be balanced for a healthy journey. It is by naming these that we can create a platform to act decisively in times of uncertainty.

1. **Continuity** - those aspects of our community that are core to who we are, that make us unique and that God calls us to be faithful to. These we need to identify and ensure we retain.
2. **Change** – those practices, attitudes and ways of being that we need to leave behind if we are to move into the future God has prepared for us.
3. **Novelty** – the new, creative and novel ideas that we now have the opportunity to experiment with.

For each person a different imperative named above is more compelling. This is why we need as many voices as possible in the conversation – so that we may uncover and find ways to balance each energy. We will end the morning by choosing the priorities that represent the first significant steps in the direction God is calling us to.
