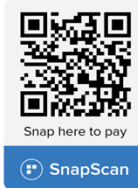

### NOTICE OF VESTRY

**Our Annual Vestry will take place today 03 March, during the 09h00 service.**

Dear Friends

I have been here for less than two months, so it might be said that it's a bit presumptuous of me to present to the Parish a 'Statement of Needs'! But, on the other hand, it might be good to have some 'Newcomer Observations', because I can see things you might be so used to living with that you don't notice. I shall be frank, because it does not help to disguise the truth. You need to know, though, at the outset, that I enjoy being here with you, and am concerned that this Parish should be happy and vibrant: as I have said, you have a beautiful church, lovely grounds, and wonderful facilities. We need to ensure that you are making the most of what you have, and that you are doing whatever you can to enable the parish to flourish. A huge turn-around is essential. Here are some observations:

1. There has been lots of talk about what needs to be done; some quotes; some real effort to raise funds - but, sadly, no follow-through. This must result in people being demoralized.
2. The financial situation you are in encourages a sense of hopelessness and paralysis. I am sure people feel overwhelmed.
3. People who serve in the Parish - the paid members of staff, and volunteers, who undertake aspects of ministry, have not been held accountable sufficiently - so there has been procrastination, inefficiency, and neglect.
4. As always, there is a shortage of committed, involved people doing the work.
5. There is lack of support for people who try to initiate things, in the life of the parish.
6. You need to make sure the church is sparkling clean, neat, attractive and inviting and does not reflect 'tiredness' and lack of interest.
7. You need to create an atmosphere of life, vitality, joy and celebration.
8. We need to get some music (we are working on it).
9. You do have very good, very committed, very competent people: there is great potential.
10. Vision and planning are essential, so you have a goal, a dream, something to get excited about and work towards.

I offer these observations, humbly, with love - and a real concern that you should be the best you can be, so that you are happy, and so that God is glorified.
