Beautiful Saints,

In our liturgical calendar August is the month of Compassion. We will be using this month to experience the depth of God’s compassion for us, to receive it and allow its healing work to make us whole. In the Gospels often the healing miracles of Jesus follow a threefold movement. First Jesus is *moved with compassion* to do the healing work. Second Jesus tells them *your sin has been forgiven*. And lastly *your faith has made you whole*. In this movement we see that all things are at the initiative of God, welling up from the depth of God’s love for us. As we become present to God’s desire for our wholeness, we grow in awareness of those ways in which our own thoughts, words and deeds contribute to broken relationships with ourselves, God and one another. When we confess how we “miss the mark” (sin) and receive God’s forgiveness we are asked to believe in the restoration offered. In trust we resolve to amend our lives and live in this newness of life to the glory of Gods Holy Name.

Our services will be echoing this threefold ministry of healing by creating and holding space for God to work His desire in us as individuals and as a community. Each Sunday will have a theme and an associated practice to implement for that week.

11 August – making space for God in life

18 August –God healing our brokenness

25 August – Experiencing the freedom Christ brings
