Dear Saints

Some years ago the Diocese of Johannesburg began to look seriously at the ministry of the Laity. It was a brave step for a number of reasons. I was privileged to be your rector at that time and was enthusiastic about much of the content. Some called it "every member ministry" and others, myself included, "the priesthood of all believers".

At the same time, the word "ministry" has a limited appeal a bit Churchy. In a sense we do not "preach" to others; rather we take ourselves and our spirituality and "be" love and caring. We try not to judge; the word "should" is a talk-down word; rather we listen and love. Empathy and sympathy link hands, unwritten and unsaid, flow to the other, trusting the Spirit whisper.

We will continue in this vein a little later. Sufficient for the moment is the recognition in each of us that we are the "Imago Dei", the image of God. Richard Rohr in his excellent series on "Justice" has this to say "Searching for and rediscovering the True Self is the fundamentum, the essential task that will gradually open us to receiving and giving love to God, others, and ourselves, and thus to live truly just lives. Grace builds on nature; it does not avoid or destroy nature. You are created in the image of God from the very beginning (Genesis 1:26-27). This is the basis for God's justice: Since everyone is made in the image of God, then we need to recognize, honor, and respect the image of God in everyone. No exceptions."
