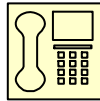

On Books

Recently I started on a spring clean of my books. A month later mess prevails - books everywhere, no order, can't find what I want to - chaos. However, within it all, there is a meeting of old friends - books long since read and books cherished. One such old friend is the much marked book on the spiritual life as taught by Meister Eckhart (c 1260-1327/8) and written by Cyprian Smith OSB.

I mention this book because it was a gift with an intriguing message from the giver who did not sign his or her name.

“You cannot abandon a sinking ship if you are tied to the mast.” I placed a call to Sherlock Holmes but more of that later.

Ruminating on the ruined order of books, I realized how valued and important a part they played in my spiritual and priestly formation. Not that all Christian books are helpful; I have pruned my shelves twice over the years of books that represent a spirituality that is somewhat unhelpful. The choice of books on theology and spirituality is very wide and great care should be shown in the books you select. It would be very helpful if you consulted a respected source such as your priest(s) or someone who is a trusted source.

Personal spiritual growth and exploration is is not the prerogative of the few but the many. The beautiful journey is a road open to everyone. There is a special joy when you read spiritual books with the Spirit sitting on your shoulder and whispering to you.
