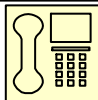

### On the Path – listening deeply. Further steps on the Journey. 6.

*Awaken! Listen in silence for the  
Voice of the Counselor.*

Time and time again we are exhorted to go into silence and to listen deeply. Here in the in a reworking of Psalm 105 by Nan Merrill we are exhorted to “awaken”, to become aware and attentive to the Spirit working within. Silence, quieting the tumble and rumble of thought, fears and illusion. Nan Merrill again:

*As we sift through our dreams,  
guide us to the only Dream  
that brings peace-  
knowing we belong to you.  
Give us wisdom and courage to release  
all that binds;  
for, to face what is built on an illusion  
is to find new life.*

To become deeply spiritual, to don the “mind of Christ”, is a journey – but not alone. Silence or the process of silence is the portal to the Deeper Mind. This portal is a place of gentle expectancy.

Last week we visited Joyce Rupp and her beautiful book “My soul feels lean”. She writes:

“I find that intentionally easing the fast pace of my days is indispensable if a spirit of hope is to be sustained in tough times. Being overly active and involved in the constant bombardment of social media and other stress-induced activities whittles away my ability to go to the deeper places of my life. Without daily attention to what lies beyond the outer world I can easily get mired in the non-essentials and miss the hidden movement leading to future maturity.”

Finding the space in our lives for some silence is often the tricky thing. Don't give up! Next week a couple of handy silence tools.
