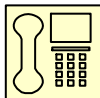

Patronal Festival 2018

By the grace of God, we have arrived at yet another Patronal festival. The journey has been quite different this year. It began with one of us recognizing that we were ill as a community and in need of healing. To that end I have spent the last five weeks preparing us for a massive healing experience. I'm expecting a glorious experience of Sunday. There are perhaps a couple of prerequisites to that. Firstly, we must acknowledge our woundedness or our sickness in whatever form it occurs. Secondly, we must acknowledge God's grace that will heal us and thirdly to expect the gift of healing.

We have been in a state of deep prayer as a parish so I'm not doubting the miracle. I lost my driver's license recently and needed it desperately and urgently. I simply could not find it anywhere. So, I prayed, and God answered and said check your jacket pockets. I went through every jacket I owned and in the final pocket of the final jacket, there it was.

Here's the rub though. I knew it was there, just knew, and when I put my hand in that pocket it was in anticipation of finding, grabbing and bringing it out. It was the most extraordinary thing. I had no doubt it was there, and that I'd found it. After all, God said it was there.

Similarly, our healing is right where and when God said it would happen – on Sunday 11th of November. Expect to find healing in every sphere of your life. and as I put my hand in that pocket so should you present yourself to God – expectantly, knowing that restoration is imminent.

Today your life is restored to fullness and wholeness! Receive it. Alleluia Amen!
