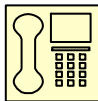

From the pews.

The demand for perfectionism seems so loud in our modern times

Dear Friends,

The calling to be Christians either by service in the laity or the priesthood is one and the same thing: we serve our God and we serve our sister and brothers both within and without the church. We serve as best we can - neither demanding perfectionism in thought, word and deed nor denying that we as a people all fall short.

"Home is, ultimately, that place where we find peace and harmony that comes from learning to live with the knowledge of our own imperfections and from learning to accept the imperfections of others." Home can exist in various settings, but its ultimate foundation rests jointly within self and within some group of trusted others. The following story written in a lovely book "The Spirituality of Imperfection - storytelling and the search for meaning" by Kurtz and Katherine Ketchum, illustrates one of the settings for "home":

A man was looking for a good church to attend and he happened to enter one in which the congregation and the priest were reading from the prayer book. They were saying " We have left undone those things which we ought to have done, and we have done those things which we ought not to have done."

The man dropped into a seat and sighed with relief as he said to himself

" Thank goodness, I've found my crowd at last."
