Beautiful saints called and planted by grace in this place, peace be upon you.

This morning we celebrate three events. First the great festival of our church, Trinity Sunday. Second, we mark the anniversary of the June 16 uprisings and all that this meant in our tumultuous history. And lastly, closer to home we celebrate Father's Day.

Each of these events hold in common the centrality of *relationships*. And call us to a time of reflection on our relationships, not only with one another, but how these become the ground of our relationship with God. We are reminded by Catherine of Avila that "*every vice and every virtue is exercised in relationship*".
