# **Meditation**

"I want to unfold you. Let no place in me hold itself closed. Where I am closed, I am false. I want stay clear in your sight.

These few short lines are from a longer work by Rilke. Although written in his earlier years, the words still contain wisdom for us as we struggle with "change" and all its manifestations. There is ample evidence that in the not too distant future motor vehicles will not need a human driver. In a relatively short time we have moved from the "horseless carriage" to the verge of the "driverless car". Change is a coming even in Christian thinking and practice - as vacant pews evidence.

Rilke, in these lines, is addressing God. Each line is worthy of your attention.

It is a gentle meditation which I hope will feed your souls.
