THE READINGS

FIRST READING : Leviticus 19 : 1-2, 9-18 The LORD said to Moses, ²“Speak to the entire assembly of Israel and say to them: ‘Be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy. ⁹“When you reap the harvest of your land, do not reap to the very edges of your field or gather the gleanings of your harvest. ¹⁰Do not go over your vineyard a second time or pick up the grapes that have fallen. Leave them for the poor and the foreigner. I am the LORD your God. ¹¹“Do not steal. ¹²“Do not lie. ¹³“Do not deceive one another. ¹⁴“Do not swear falsely by my name and so profane the name of your God. I am the LORD. ¹⁵“Do not defraud or rob your neighbour. ¹⁶“Do not hold back the wages of a hired worker overnight. ¹⁷“Do not curse the deaf or put a stumbling block in front of the blind, but fear your God. I am the LORD. ¹⁸“Do not pervert justice; do not show partiality to the poor or favouritism to the great, but judge your neighbour fairly. ¹⁹“Do not go about spreading slander among your people. ²⁰“Do not do anything that endangers your neighbour’s life. I am the LORD. ²¹“Do not hate a fellow Israelite in your heart. Rebuke your neighbour frankly so you will not share in their guilt. ²²“Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbour as yourself. I am the LORD.

PSALM 119 : 33-40 (Pg 758 APB)

SECOND READING : 1 Corinthians 3 : 10-11, 16-23 ¹⁰By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as a wise builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should build with care. ¹¹For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ.

¹⁶Don’t you know that you yourselves are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in your midst? ¹⁷If anyone destroys God’s temple, God will destroy that person; for God’s temple is sacred, and you together are that temple. ¹⁸Do not deceive yourselves. If any of you think you are wise by the standards of this age, you should become “fools” so that you may become wise. ¹⁹For the wisdom of this world is foolishness in God’s sight. As it is written: “He catches the wise in their craftiness” ²⁰and again, “The Lord knows that the thoughts of the wise are futile.” ²¹So then, no more boasting about human leaders! All things are yours, ²²whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future—all are yours, ²³and you are of Christ, and Christ is of God.

GOSPEL : Matthew 5 : 38-48 ³⁸“You have heard that it was said, ‘Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth.’ ³⁹But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also. ⁴⁰And if anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, hand over your coat as well. ⁴¹If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles. ⁴²Give to the one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you. ⁴³“You have heard that it was said, ‘Love your neighbour and hate your enemy.’ ⁴⁴But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵that you may be children of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. ⁴⁶If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? ⁴⁷And if you greet only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? ⁴⁸Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.
