Dear Friends

I thought that I'd take this opportunity to introduce myself to you, again, and tell you a little about how I see the next few months, whilst I am with you, working out.

I have been asked to 'look after' the Parish for two to three months, when someone will replace me, here, for a longer stay with you. That means I will be here until the end of February, at least - and, possibly, until the end of March. As I have said to the congregations on the last two Sundays, I am a retired Anglican priest - I retired on 1st April, 2017, from the Parish of Kempton Park, Diocese of the Highveld. Prior to that, I was Assistant Priest at St George's, Parktown, for twelve years. And prior to that, I was a priest in the Diocese of KZN. Recently, I have been helping at St Michael's, Bryanston. I am married to Gill, and we have three adult children, two of whom are married. Sarah, who is the Rector at St Andrew's, Ferndale, with her husband, Andrew, have given us our three gorgeous grandchildren.

Gill and I live near Cresta, which is a fair distance away. In addition, we have just one car to share between us - so I won't be coming through to the Office every day during the week, when the Office is open. Appointments will need to be made through Lorelle, in the Office, at times that will be convenient. If you need to see me, don't hesitate to make contact. I don't plan on starting a programme of parish visiting, or anything like that, because I am with you for such a short time. Obviously, it will be difficult to get to know all of you - but I will try my best!

I will be available, if required, for baptisms, weddings and funerals - in line with whatever parish policies have been in practice. In addition, I will attend - and, possibly, chair - Executive, Parish Council, and Parish Minister meetings. There might be other meetings/gatherings that it might be appropriate for me to attend.

Please make contact with me, should you need to discuss anything. I am aware that there is a Choir which operates at the 09h00 Service on a Sunday, sometimes. I will choose three or four songs/hymns for the 09h00 Service - unless I am consulted, and notified that other arrangements have been made.

It would be wonderful if we could work together harmoniously and well, for the next few months, so that the Parish flourishes. It is not my intention to introduce anything new, or change anything major, unless it flows from a decision made by Parish Council. But life for All Saints must proceed, as usual. And I hope we will worship, grow and serve happily together.
