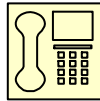

### From the pews

“The world is full of Christians yet nothing changes. It may be time to change the tune. Let’s dance with Eve and go in search of Lilith, the first of our foresters to refuse the embodiment of destructive hierarchy” - Lisa Isherwood.

In last weeks pew leaflet, we quoted De Chardin who advises us to “trust in the slow work of God” both in ourselves and I would suggest, in the Church. Maybe, however, the time, as Lisa Isherwood (above) suggests, “to change our tune.” Two thousand years have passed since Jesus walked on the earth’s soil leaving us his words and deeds and life example. During this time we have gone in many directions, followed many roads - and now we find ourselves, once again, needing to find a new direction.

It’s nothing really new. The question is how and where. O’Murchu, author of the excellent book “Catching up to Jesus”:

“ Of all the urgent needs for the Christian church today, none is more pressing than the need to reclaim the prophetic face of Jesus. Anything less is only another form perpetuating the cult of insipid spiritualism and the ideology of compromise.”

“If we truly honour the Jesus of the Kingdom of God, what we encounter is a visionary afire with the living Spirit of God, animated with the intense passion of the prophet, enlightened with the deep perception of the mystic, and grounded in the slime and texture of the living earth. Truly this is God with the people, the Emmanuel in a fiercely real way. This is not a God for devotional seclusion, for evangelical rhetoric, or for heady academic analysis.

*This is a God of engagement, participation, liberation, and compassion.”*
