Beautiful saints called and planted by grace in this place, peace be upon you.
This week President Ramaphosa gave his State of the Nation Address. Although there is merit to some of the opposition parties' comment that it was more the laying out of a dream than a practical plan, we read in Proverbs 29:8 that a "*where there is no vision, the people perish*". In this sense we are being called as South Africans to reconnect to a vision for our nation. And this same call is being made by God to us as a community worshipping at All Saints. Last week I shared our "vision statement" which is our current best discernment of God's desire for us in this place. I also asked each of you to begin prayerfully discerning how the Holy Spirit might be prompting your involvement in making this a reality. *Encountering the love of God in our relationships. Sharing our journey as we discover God in the plan and learning to trust God for every situation*
From this statement we identified 4 focus areas for the next 12 months, as well as a convenor for that area.

- ✓ Sharing the message with others – James
Each of us is called as priests of God to minister to a broken and wounded world. This focus area is to create platforms for our ministry to others. A key component is drawing others into this space and community. This team would be responsible for thinking through our "brand" (i.e. what is the core of our message) as well as "marketing & communication strategies" (i.e. how do we reach out).
- ✓ Beautifying the space – Penny
Through the generosity of God's people, we have a beautiful physical space to create a worshipping community. This focus area will be looking at ways to steward this space as well as ways to make it more inviting for prayer, worship and fellowship. We already have identified two projects – building a meditation garden and establishing a labyrinth. However, there is much to do both inside and outside of the church.
- ✓ Pastoral care – Di
As a community of faith we are called to care for one another, to deepen our relationships and to journey together through the seasons of life. This focus area seeks to find ways to make this practical especially by being present for one another in the ordinary and everyday of our lives.
- ✓ Social / Fellowship opportunities – Del
As the family of God we are called into fellowship with God and one another. This focus area seeks to create opportunities for us to be together in ways that nurture our deepest need for connections. A possible project already identified is to host a "supper club" that allows us to be together in more informal ways.

I am excited about the future God has prepared for us and want to again invite you to prayerfully discern where you would like to put your time, talents and effort in growing our community.
