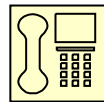

**Join the world for 9 days of prayer between Ascension Day and Pentecost Sunday**

*"Thy Kingdom Come"*

**Choose three people you will pray for over these 9 days**

Praying for others to know the love of God is one of the most powerful things we can do. Persistent prayer for others brings transformation to their lives. Consistently praying for others takes discipline, and there are many ways that we can build up habits that will help us to pray for others.

1. Choose 3 people you commit to praying for.
2. Take 3 small stones and write the name of each of the people onto each of the stones.
3. For the next 9 days keep these stones with you as a reminder to pray for them daily.

Using the "BLESS" acronym can help us to focus on all of the felt needs of those we are praying for:

- **B**ody – health, protection, energy
- **L**abour – employment / unemployment, retirement, adequate income
- **E**motional – inner peace, joy, wisdom, insight, patience
- **S**ocial – healthy relationships between spouses, parents, children, friends, reconciliation, love
- **S**piritual – repentance, salvation, obedience, faith

### **You might like to use the following prayers as you pray for others**

Loving Lord, Please work in me so I can share your love, life and message with... Reveal your love to them, that they might know, follow and witness to you, for Your glory. Amen.

Loving Father, Send your Holy Spirit so I can share your love, life and message with... Reveal Jesus to them, that they might know, follow and love him, for Your glory. Amen.

You build your church through the power of your Spirit. By the same Spirit enable me to witness to... your love, beauty and grace, that they may come to the fellowship of the faithful for Your glory. Amen.

Lord, I pray that you will lead... to you. Thank you that you love them. I pray that you would break into their life and show them your love, grace and peace, for Your glory. Amen.
