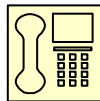

Over the past weeks we have delved deeper into consciousness and a spirituality that seeks to serve in love and sharing. We looked into the hearts and minds that feed the way. We were challenged by Richard Rohr: *"This is the basis for God's justice: Since everyone is made in the image of God, then we need to recognize, honor, and respect the image of God in everyone. No exceptions."*

Jean Pierre de Caussade the 18th century French Jesuit coined the phrase: "the sacrament of the present moment."

*"The Divine will
Is a deep abyss
Of which the present
Moment is the entrance."*

The world consciousness and religious spirituality are changing but the urgency exists, not only for our country but the world. Irwin Lazlo the founder of the Club of Budapest, wrote a decade ago, of the urgency: "A cultural mutation can be willfully launched and consciously oriented. The conscious orientation of the next cultural mutation - the shift to a new civilization - depends on the evolution of our consciousness. This has become a precondition of our collective survival."

Those beautiful words of de Caussade, echoed by Eckhart Tolle's global best seller, "The Power of Now" suggest that God's will, this deep abyss, can best be found

*If you plunge
Into this abyss
you will find it
infinitely more vast
than your desires.*

It is necessary, to be disengaged from all we feel and do in order to walk with God in the duty of the present. Go deeper, plunge into the mind of God, then become the spacious presence that is the root and ground of all that happens.
