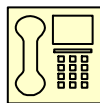

Thy Kingdom come...from where



One of the dangers of oft-repeated prayer is that it can be treated as a national anthem where we sing along without pausing to understand the meaning behind the words. The Lord's prayer is one such prayer especially the line "thy Kingdom come thy will be done on earth as it is heaven".

This line tells us two things immediately. That there us a Kingdom up there and it has an organised structure which we should be "willing" that it be transferred to us on earth.

The psalmist gives us a further clue when he says "The Lord has set his throne in heaven. His kingdom rules everything".

Psalms 103:19 GW. This must be a Kingdom from the ancient days before time began because God's name is "Ancient of Days". He is therefore a king with a heavenly domain and subjects. Who were His subjects and what kind of social system did they have ?

The answer to this is the reason the Christian faith exists. To prepare us well so that we can receive what God wanted to transfer to another domain when He first created man. Earth was to be an outpost of the heavenly Kingdom and Adam was to start of a heaven on earth. The rest is not history ; because the bible covers God's attempts to reclaim the royal domain man lost by sin.

So when the disciples asked Jesus " teach us to pray" he made "the Kingdom" the first order of prayer after the Father's name had been hallowed. He was basically teaching them to ask that the lost heavenly Kingdom be restored.

Jesus is the only one with authority as the second Adam to restore the lost Kingdom that is why he commissioned many disciples to go and do likewise.

Have you received the Kingdom of God ? The route to the Kingdom lies with the accepting Jesus as heaven's royal representative to reign over your life. If you do then His statement in Luke 17:21 that the " Kingdom of God is within you "

shall be a reality. May the Kingdom of God come upon your life so that His will becomes your will.
