Dear Friends

At our last Parish Council meeting, we decided that it would be a good idea to have a planning meeting, so that we can talk about really important stuff that we don't have time for at ordinary Parish Council meetings. The Wardens and I thought that we should open this meeting up to anyone who is interested in participating. It would be very helpful to have input from people who are involved in different aspects of ministry at All Saints. Our hope is that we will get comments and suggestions from as many people as possible. Our aim will be to pool thoughts and ideas, at the Planning Meeting, which the Parish Council will discuss further, and decide what to implement. We are hoping to have some interested people at the meeting, and have written comments and suggestions from people who are unable to attend, or who don't want to attend. We suggest that the written comments and suggestions are inserted into the Honesty Box – although, normally, it's only money that is placed in the box, it is appropriately named for honest input from parishioners!

I suggest that you ask yourself the following questions:

1. What do I really like about All Saints?
2. What do I think our strengths are?
3. What do I not like about All Saints?
4. What do I consider weaknesses of this Parish?
5. What would I like to see happening here?
6. What practical suggestions can I make, to improve worship, fellowship, outreach, youth work, spiritual growth, outreach, or anything else at All Saints?
7. What would I like to be involved in?

These questions are just a guideline – you are free to say anything about anything, as long as it pertains to the Parish of All Saints. You don't have to answer all these questions. You don't have to write pages and pages (in fact, we'd prefer it if you didn't!). You might just want to say one thing. We would love to hear from you. We are aware that most people don't respond to this kind of invitation – but we are hoping YOU will! You are welcome to remain anonymous, if you feel this is necessary – otherwise, put your name on the piece of paper you place in the Honesty Box.
